LEAD to Inspire

"I'm blessed to lead a company like UPS, but the truth is, the past two years have been really hard for our team. UPSers are essential workers.

During the pandemic, they didn't work from home – they got up every day and sorted and delivered packages with volumes that reached unprecedented levels. I believe I was called to lead this company to inspire our workers ... to support them in their efforts ... to celebrate them. I lead to inspire our people. They are why I get out of bed in the morning."

"I believe any good leader has a servant's heart, always putting those around them first in everything they do. For me, serving to create is about investing in people so they can reach their highest potential – whatever that is.

I'm so proud of people that I've invested in – people who worked for me who are now CFOs of publicly traded companies, people who worked for me who are now CEOs of publicly traded companies. Investing in someone's development to help them reach their highest potential ... putting them before yourself ... is a joy."

"At UPS, we recently had the privilege of hosting Lin-Manuel Miranda, the creator of Hamilton. I got to interview him – it was really cool. One of the lyrics he wrote that really resonates with me is: "When you are gone, who remembers your name? Who keeps your flame? Who tells your story?"

Think about Martha Berry (the Berry College founder). We are still telling her story. That's because she gave to others above all else. A spirit of giving transcends time, it transforms lives, and it lights the way for the next generation.



Carol B. Tomé is the Chief Executive Officer of UPS. She is the 12th CEO in the 114-year history of the company. Before joining UPS, Carol served as Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of The Home Depot, Inc., one of the world's largest retailers.

Carol began her journey with The Home Depot in 1995 as Vice President and Treasurer. From May 2001 until her retirement in September 2019, Carol held the title of Executive Vice President and CFO.



In March of 2020, she was named CEO of UPS, one of the world's largest global logistics companies and is steadfastly leading the shipping giant through its third year of a worldwide exploding ecommerce market, gaining international recognition for her supply chain solutions while also making strides in social impact and diversity initiatives.

In addition to her responsibilities at UPS, Carol also serves as a trustee and board member of the Atlanta Botanical Garden, GIA Partners, Grady Hospital, Sovos Brands, and Verizon. She is a member of The Committee of 200, The Buckhead Coalition, The Business Roundtable, The Business Council, and the International Business Council of The World Economic Forum. She and her husband, Ramon, established the Tomé Scholars to Fellows Program and the Tomé Foundation in 2019 to support non-profit organizations that enable communities to protect natural resources, empower people for success, energize the arts, and embrace diversity.

Carol has twice been named to the Forbes list of The World's 100 Most Powerful Women and was selected for the inaugural 2021 Forbes 50 Over 50 list. Also in 2021, she was ranked #4 of the top 50 Most Powerful Women in Business by Fortune magazine and was ranked #5 in 2020. Carol has also been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades – most recently she was honored with the 2022 Eisenhower Award by the Business Executives for National Security, the 2021 Unity for a Difference Social Equity Award from Families First, and the Atlanta American Jewish Committee's 2019 National Human Relations Award. Carol and Ramon enjoy spending their free time on their farm in Chickamauga, GA.
