Long before mixed-income housing and large-scale public-private partnerships became widely accepted models, Egbert was advancing the idea that strong, holistic development could produce both economic value and stronger communities at the same time. Many of the concepts Integral helped pioneer fundamentally changed the way cities, investors, and developers approached the complexity of responsible urban redevelopment across the country.

Impact remains the ultimate measure of the work. Beyond the buildings themselves, Egbert has consistently focused on whether a development creates opportunity, attracts investment, strengthens neighborhoods, and leaves a city better positioned for the future than it was before. At Integral, that work continues.

Together, these three principles have shaped not only Egbert Perry's career but also Integral's lasting influence on the built environment in Atlanta and cities throughout the nation.

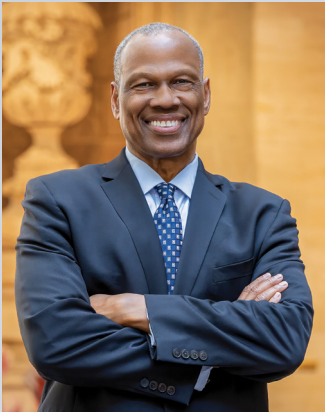

EGBERT PERRY

Egbert L.J. Perry is a nationally recognized real estate leader whose work has helped reshape how cities approach growth, equity, and long-term community stability. As Chairman of The Integral Group, which he co-founded in 1993, he has spent more than three decades advancing a disciplined development model grounded in partnership and a clear understanding of the relationship between the built environment and economic opportunity. Since its founding, Integral has implemented numerous public-private partnerships that promote responsible urban development.

Perry is widely recognized for his leadership in the creation of Centennial Place in Atlanta, the nation's first urban mixed-use, economically integrated community. Perry developed the mixed-income community development concept, while the Atlanta Housing Authority and a St. Louis-based development partner collaborated with Integral to execute and scale the model at Centennial Place. The project established a new standard for community revitalization by integrating early childhood development, K-12 public education, recreation and wellness facilities, mixed-income housing, retail uses, and support services designed to help low-income families transition into the economic mainstream. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development later designated this holistic approach as a national model, and versions of it have since been replicated in more than 250 communities across the country.

Under Perry's leadership, Integral has become a national development, management, and investment company with a portfolio that includes mixed-use communities, transit-oriented developments, and affordable, workforce, and Class A multifamily housing development. The company has created approximately 10,000 housing units and is recognized for executing complex public-private partnerships that connect investment discipline with long-term community impact.

A graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, Perry earned both Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees in Civil Engineering, along with an MBA in Finance and Accounting from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. His career reflects a consistent throughline of integrity, vision, and durable impact on the communities his work serves.
